# Consultant Training of Tepu community in sustainable harvesting of fish

Conservation International Suriname (CI Suriname) is looking for a consultant to provide a training in "Sustainable harvesting of ornamental fish" for a period of 5,5 months.

CI-Suriname is in the process of starting a sustainable livelihood project in the Trio village of Tepu. This project consists of the setup of an ornamental fisheries enterprise which will help to generate more income for the community. The objective of this consultancy is to strengthen the community in sustainable harvesting of ornamental fishes and to improve the survival rate of fishes that will be exported.

- A bachelor's degree or higher in Agricultural Science (Aquaculture) and/or Business Management and/or Infrastructure.
- Five years' work experience in tropical fish trade and business.
- Knowledge of (ornamental) fish that live in the source rivers of South-East Suriname/ Tapanahonyriver
- Good communication skills.
- Highly organized and able to multitask and prioritize tasks.
- Flexible and adaptable to changing work environments.
- Experience to work with Indigenous organizations/ communities is a pre.
- Excellent Dutch and English proficiency, both in speaking and writing.
- Excellent knowledge of Sranan Tongo

- Understanding of the challenges and cultural background of Indigenous communities 3 pts
- Experience in effectively training groups of people who are not familiar with the subjects and the ability to convey complex details or technical information 3 pts
- Comprehensive technical proposal on how to conduct Capacity Building training 3 pts
- English and Dutch proficiency, both in speaking and writing 3 pts
- Highly familiar employing cultural awareness and sensitivity 3 pts
- Budget 3 pts
