Consultancy: Biodiversity Baseline Study

Conservation International Suriname (CI Suriname) is looking for a consultant for a **Biodiversity Baseline Study in Tepu** to execute project activities for a period of 6 weeks. For a potential Conservation Agreement, including a sustainable ornamental fisheries project in Tepu it is necessary to establish a Biodiversity Baseline of the village area to set the stage for effective conservation actions and benefits in the context of the TWTIS program. This Biodiversity Baseline Study will be used to measure the effectiveness of the implemented conservation actions.

The objective of the consultancy is to gather the necessary ecological baseline information and the development of an ecological monitoring protocol to facilitate the measurement of the effectiveness of conservation actions and sustainable development interventions on community level.

Requirements

Applicant should meet the following requirements:

- A relevant Bachelor's degree or higher in a biological, environmental or agricultural science
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience in Biodiversity Baseline Assessments with local communities in Suriname
- Dutch and English proficiency, both in speaking and writing
- Sranang tongo speaking and writing are a pre

Selection Criteria

- Overall quality of CV and Cover Letter 3 pts
- Education Requirement 3 pts
- Work Experience Requirement- 3 pts
- Strong biodiversity field data gathering skills including the ability to effectively convey complex details or technical information 3 pts
- Experience with similar projects- 3 pts
- Understanding of the challenges and cultural background of Indigenous communities and the use of ecosystem services by indigenous communities 3 pts
- English proficiency, both in speaking and writing 3 pts
- Highly familiar employing cultural awareness and sensitivity 3 pts
- Comprehensive technical proposal on how to conduct biodiversity baseline studies and community- based biodiversity monitoring- 3 pts
- Budget 3 pts
