

# Request for Proposal

## Consultancy: Sustainability Plan Tuhka Enterprise Alalapadu

Conservation International Suriname (CI Suriname) is looking for a consultant to establish a **Sustainability Plan for the Tuhka Enterprise in Alalapadu,** for a period of 3 months.

With the assistance of CI-Suriname a sustainable livelihood project was implemented in the Trio village, Alalapadu by creating possibilities to produce, and assist in selling Tuhka oil (Brazil nut oil) and Tuhka roasted nuts, which generate more income for the community.

The objective of this consultancy is to provide and develop tools by establishing a comprehensive sustainability plan for the Tuhka enterprise of Alalapadu to become independent. This plan should be a participatory plan, which need to be established in collaboration with Stichting Tuhka and CI-Suriname. This objective is linked to output 3.1 (Expand Sustainable Livelihoods) in the Our Future Forests–Amazonia Verde project.
