Consultancy: Socio Economic Baseline Study

Conservation International Suriname (CI Suriname) is looking for a consultant for a Socio-Economic Baseline in Brownsweg to execute project activities for a period of 3 months. For starting a community development project in Brownsweg it is necessary to gather baseline information that will allow CI staff to acquire a much better understanding of, and appreciation for the way of life of the tribal communities at Brownsweg, and how to work with the communities to develop a set of indicators on individual-level, household-level, community-level, and project-level which will be used for annual monitoring of the community development project in Brownsweg.

The objective of the consultancy is to gather the necessary baseline information to facilitate effective conservation and sustainable development interventions at the community level based in Brownsweg to execute a community development project. This baseline focusses specifically on the human population, and less on ecological factors.

Requirements

Applicant should meet the following requirements:

- A relevant master's degree or higher in a social science;
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience in Socio Economic Baseline Assessments with Tribal communities in Suriname;
- Dutch and English proficiency, both in speaking and writing.
- Sranang Tongo and/or local dialects: speaking and writing are a pre.

Selection Criteria

- Overall quality of CV and Cover Letter 3 pts
- Education Requirement 3 pts
- Work Experience Requirement- 3 pts
- Strong communication & presentation skills including the ability to effectively convey complex details or technical information 3 pts
- Experience with similar projects- 3 pts
- Understanding of the challenges and cultural background of Indigenous communities 3 pts
- English proficiency, both in speaking and writing 3 pts
- Highly familiar employing cultural awareness and sensitivity 3 pts
- Comprehensive technical proposal on how to measure socio economic baseline studies 3 pts
- Budget 3 pts
