

Terms of Reference

Consultancy: Machine Operations & Maintenance

Conservation International Suriname (CI Suriname) is looking for a consultant for a Machine Operations and Maintenance Training in Alalapadu to execute project activities for a period of 6 weeks.

The objective of this consultancy is to provide approximately 15 people of Stichting Tuhka and the Brazil nut facility workers with training in machine operations and maintenance and train at least 5 people in maintenance and repair of other equipment such as outboard motor, chain saw and cassava mill. These trainings should result in acquired knowledge about the technical aspects of the machines in the facility, ability to repair and perform regular maintenance which finally result in efficient and effective operating equipment and contribute to a sustainable production process and use of other equipment.

Requirements

Applicant should meet the following requirements:

- An experienced Mechanical Engineer
- A minimum of five (5) years' experience in maintenance and machine operations
- Experience in training local communities, especially community development enterprises in Suriname
- Dutch and English proficiency, both in speaking and writing
- Excellent knowledge of Sranan Tongo

Selection Criteria

- Education Requirement 3 pts
- Work Experience Requirement- 3 pts
- Experience in mechanical processes and equipment repair including the ability to effectively convey complex details or technical information 3 pts
- Experience with similar projects- 3 pts
- Understanding of the challenges and cultural background of Indigenous communities 3 pts
- English and Dutch proficiency, both in speaking and writing 3 pts
- Highly familiar employing cultural awareness and sensitivity 3 pts
- Comprehensive technical proposal on how to conduct training in machine operations and maintenance 3 pts
