	The CoP provides overall leadership, management, and general technical direction of the entire CSF program, ensuring an integrated vision among different components and stakeholders and a focus on achieving the results defined in the donor agreement.

	This position serves as the main point of contact for donor relations and all other counterparts and implementing partners. This position manages the preparation and presentation of all proposed implementation plans and reports, as well as any other duties required that may arise during the program.
